



No. 236. Lace Sweater in Glow Crinkle

LACE SWEATER IN GLOW CRINKLE

No. 236 — Slip-on Sweater — Size 34-36

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

4 balls of Bernat Glow Crinkle Blue 2216
1 Circular Bone Needle No. 4
1 Pair Straight Bone Needles No. 4
1 Pair Straight Steel Needles No. 12
1 Bone Crochet Hook No. 4

INSTRUCTIONS

With circular needle cast on 150 sts.
K 2 sts., P 2 sts. for 3 inches.
K 1 row plain adding 1 stitch every 5.
K these 180 sts. 1 row.
Follow pattern for 8 inches.

Pattern:

*Row 1, 2, 3, 4: Yarn over needle, K 2 sts. together, Yarn over needle, K 2 sts. together. (On row 2, be sure the first of the 2 sts. K together is the loose stitch.)

Row 5: K 2 rows plain.

Row 7: Repeat from * until pattern measures 8 inches.

Divide 180 sts. — 90 sts. for front of sweater and 90 sts. for back.

Work back first: Bind off 3 sts. each end of needle. Use straight bone needles No. 4.

K 1 row, P 1 row decreasing 1 st. each end of needle every K row 6 times. K 1 row, P 1 row until work measures 18 inches. Bind off loosely.

Front of Sweater: Bind off 3 sts. each end of needle. K 1 row, P 1 row decreasing 1 st. each end of needle every K row 3 times. Divide 78 sts. 39 sts. on each needle.

Work one side at a time. Decrease 1 st. at neck edge every 4th row, at same time decrease 1 st. at arm size every K row until 6 sts. have been decreased. About the 16th row K 10 sts., K 2 sts. together 5 times which will decrease work 5 sts. Continue knitting 1 row and purling 1 row until there are 22 sts. and work is even with the back. Bind off loosely.

K other side to correspond.

Puff Sleeve: Cast on No. 4 straight bone needle 14 sts. K 1 row and P 1 row increasing 1 st. at each end of needle both on K row and P row until there are 70 sts. on needle.

K 70 sts. (K 1 row, P 1 row) for 2 inches.

Transfer to steel needles: K 2, P 2 for 1 inch. Bind off loosely.

K other sleeve to correspond.

Finishing

Sew shoulders together. Sew in sleeves.

Crochet 1 row on bottom of sleeves and around neck.

Three-Piece Boucle Suit

Belt

Chain 1 inch longer than waist measure. S.C. in each chain st. around and round until belt is $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide.

COAT

Cast on No. 2 needles 110 sts. K 1 row, P 1 row for 17 inches including border pattern. Do patterns of hemstitching same as skirt. Bind off 5 sts. at each end. Decrease 1 st. at each end 7 times. K 7 inches to shoulder.

Pick up 25 sts. K $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches. * Add 1 st. every 5th st. Knit 1 inch repeat from * K 1 inch, repeat from *. Continue to knit adding the 7 sts. as decreased on back and the 5 sts. for underarm. K 17 inches. Hemstitch pattern border. Do other front to correspond. Crochet s.c. around coat 7 times.

Sleeves

Cast on No. 2 bone needles, 35 sts., add 2 sts. at each end on knit rows until there are 80 sts. on needle. Knit 20 rows plain (K 1 row and P 1 row). Then begin decreasing 1 st. at each end every 6th row until work measures $14\frac{1}{2}$ inches from underarm. Do pattern of hemstitching as border on skirt. Crochet s.c. around bottom for 7 rows. Sew up and block as directed in book.
