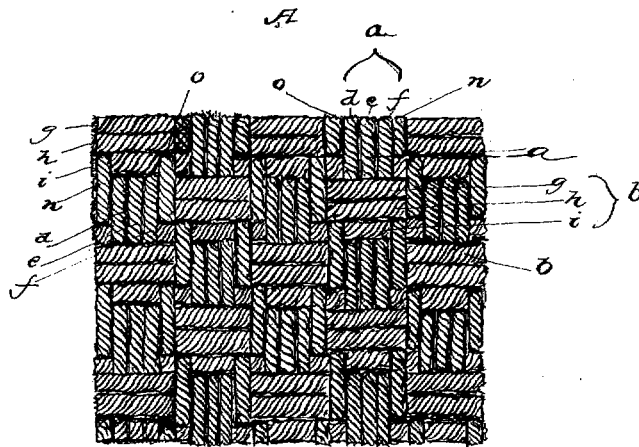

DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 19,208, dated July 16, 1889.

Application filed November 23, 1888. Serial No. 291,722. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, JOHN S. LAMOND and COLIN T. ROBERTSON, citizens of the United States, residing at Paterson, in the county of Passaic and State of New Jersey, have invented a new and original Design for Carpets, of which the following is a specification.

In the accompanying drawing is illustrated a piece of carpet embodying our design.

10 The design is a pattern, and it comprises a series of groups of figures lettered *a* and *b*, these groups of figures being arranged in the order shown. The group *a* comprises the three bars *d e f*, with a shorter bar *n* and *o* respectively outside of the interior longer bars

d e f. The group *b*, however, comprises two long bars *g* and *h*, running transversely of the bars in groups *a*, with the short bar *i* outside of the longer bars *g h*, as shown. The pattern as thus shown secures a pleasing effect.

We claim—

The design for a carpet, as herein described, and shown in the accompanying drawing.
