Extra Credit Assignment 2

The purpose of this assignment is to encourage you to spend some time right away experimenting with Ruby. Up to five homework points may be earned on this assignment. Those points will be added to your score on the first regular Ruby assignment.

The assignment is simply this: Use `irb` to evaluate ten fairly different Ruby expressions. When done, `turnin` a file named `log` that provides evidence of your work. Just copy the session text from an `ssh` window onto the clipboard and then put it into a file on `lectura` with the command "`cat >log`" (`cat` will wait for input; click to paste, then use control-D to terminate `cat`. You should then have a file named `log`, but be sure it contains what you expect.)

Use the `turnin` tag `372_x2` to submit your work:

```
turnin 372_x2 log
```

You might start by trying some of the examples on the slides and then do some what-ifs based on what strikes your curiosity.

It's hard to define what I think of as "fairly different Ruby expressions" but use common sense and note that the purpose here is to encourage some hands-on work with Ruby as soon as possible.
