1. Introduction

2. Procedure

1. Check out one of the lock-picking sets from the 9th floor academic office.
2. Practice until you can pick as many of the locks marked 1-5 as possible.
3. *You cannot use the rake, only a regular pick and the tension wrench!*
4. *You cannot do raking or lock bumping!*

3. Assessment

1. Sign up with the TA for an assessment. You will get 15 minutes to try to open as many of the locks as you can.

3. You will get the following marks, out of 100, depending on the number of locks you can open:
